### **PROFILE:**

Forum for Good Governance is a not for profit organization registered under the Societies Registration Act. ### **Forum for Good Governance:**

- Make efforts to collect the information about the **antecedents** of contesting candidates and the criminal background of such candidates was exposed through media so that the people will have information before they vote.
- Collect the data from the police and the excise departments analyzed and brought to the notice of the **Election Commission** of India.
- File public interest litigation in the high court which directed the government to fill up the vice chancellor and other posts within 3 to 4 months.
- Conduct workshops with the Police department, Judiciary and Civil Societies.
- Challenged the move to regularize Irregular amendments to **GHMC** Act and obtained a stay order.
