PROFILE:

Dr. M. Venkaiah Dy. Civil Surgeon and Asst. Prof. (Surgery) at Regional Institute of Medical

Sciences, Ongole hails from a family belonging to a socially and economically weaker section of

the society. He obtained his training in Basic Laparoscopic Techniquest at Bombay Hospital in

the year 1996. He pioneered the method of sterilizing women as part of the Family Planning

Drive undertaken by the government of India / Andhra Pradesh using the Double Puncture

Laparoscopic Method. This is a relatively painless method which ensures that the women of

child bearing age are able to resume their normal life in a matter of just four hours after under

going surgery.

Dr. Venkaiah initially taught the procedure to 30 Doctors who inturn trained 200 DPL surgeons

and 22,00,000 women have been benefited by using this procedure. He was instrumental in

ensuring that the state of Andhra Pradesh (United) achieved the first place in Family Planning

and Population Control in South Asia (2011). He also conducts medical camps every Sunday in

rural and remote areas of **Prakasam** district and other parts of Andhra Pradesh with the help of

IMA, Local NGO, Rotary Clubs, **Synards**, World Vision and other relevant NGOs.

He has conducted 98,800 family planning cases in the past 20 years in which 5800 cases were

complicated (post LSCS operated cases), 10,000 tubectomy cases through 6052 medical camps

conducted in rural and remote areas of Andhra Pradesh including Telangana region.

Dr. Venkaiah also setup a trust by the name "Mothers Trust" whereby he aims to continue

extending his medical services even after retirement to the poor and the needy living in the rural

and remote areas of **Prakasam** District and other parts of Andhra Pradesh.
