Interestingly, she ensures that the calves stay with their mothers, because as the young entrepreneur explains, "the cows produce good milk when they their calves in happy environs." Another important feature is that the cows on Divya's farm are fed organic food grown on the farm. And one more thing - milk from Klimom is delivered in glass bottles. Divya urges people to give up milk in satchets/packets which is about a week old by the time it reaches the consumer's doorstep and is laden with preservatives.
