If there's one thing, Bala Latha detests, it is others taking pity on her. Determined to find her place in the sun, she appeared for the Civil Services and secured the 399th rank in her very first attempt. Those who once shunned her, now vied with each other for a photo-op with her.

Bala Latha took yet another momentous decision which was to change the course of her life. It was a decision which also transformed the lives of many others. She decided to instil confidence and self-esteem in candidates from a deprived background, appearing for civil services.
