## **PROFILE:**

Hyderabad based NGO Bhagwan Mahavir Jain Relief Foundation Trust was founded by sixteen like minded Jain friends in 2009 to provide affordable health care to financially weak members of the society.

## **SERVICES**:

- The Trust conducts dialysis at a nominal price of Rs.200/-only. The Trust has so far conducted more than 6,50,000 Dialysis and has not only brought smile on the face of the patients but also saved their families from severe financial crisis.
- Apart from conducting dialysis at nominal rate the Trust has also supported patients with supply of over 862904 Erythropoietin, Iron and Levocarnite injections of reputed brands at highly subsidized rate saving more than Rs 60.0 Crores for the patients.
- The Trust started dialysis support in a small way to five patients with 16 Dialysis sessions at a private hospital in July 2009. Since then, there is no looking back and today, the Trust with five of its own Centers with 158 machines and with four associate hospitals provides dialysis services to more than 1200 patients in the twin cities.
- First Centre of the Trust was set up in 2011 at King Koti Government Hospital with 24 machines.
- Considering increasing demand for treatment and to reduce travel time for patients the Trust felt need for opening more centres in different parts of the twin cities. Management of Ramdev Rao Hospital another philanthropic and charitable organization joined hands with them and their second Center was set up in this hospital with twelve Machines in July 2012. This centre was later expanded in stages to a forty machine centre.
- Following successful implementation of King Koti and Kukatpally projects, the Trust set up another large Centre with 26 machines at Mahaveer Hospital, AC Guards, which operates four shifts. This Centre was later expanded by adding twenty six machines making it a 52 machine centre. Expanded facilities were inaugurated by the Honorable Governor of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana Shri E. S. L. Narasimhan in January 2018.
- At Mahaveer Hospital they have setup one of its kind facility dedicated to HIV & HBV patients with eight machines. All consumables at this facility are discarded after one use. Despite substantially high operating cost, they charge only Rs 200/ only per dialysis to these patients.
- In a unique partnership with Rotary club of Hyderabad Deccan, Rotary International and Gurunanak Medical Center another Centre with eight machines was set up at Secunderabad Gurudwara .Their fifth Centre with five machines was opened in June 2018 at ZOI Hospital,Attapur.
- Total 6,57,989 dialysis has been done since the inception date
- Saving of Rs.70 crores by 3997 patients for dialysis
