PROFILE:

A farmer's son and tribal lad from Thakallapally thanda, Yacharam mandal at Ranga Reddy district, Amogth Tukaram is the son of the soil. While Tukaram's financial condition was never encouraging, he never let that come in the way to his aspirations. He was interested in climbing mountains since the time he was 17 and hence took financial assistance from few Telangana officials to go ahead and climb the Mount Everest.

Today, Tukaram has been the youngest person from South India to scale Mount Everest through the South Col route which is considered to be extremely treacherous due to its high-risk terrain. This was accomplished by him at the tender age of 20 on 22nd May 2019. He has achieved the World record for being the youngest person summiting peaks in 4 different continents in a record span of 10 months.

His message on the use of Khadi in daily life, protecting nature and ultimately hoisting the national flag on the summit has left a significant impact on the masses.
